Free Dress Davs

On free dress days, appropriate clothing is expected including appropriate shorts length, covered shoulders or no bare midriffs for all ages prek through 8th. This includes Spirit Wear days throughout the year and special class free dress days. Some schools in our area have stopped free dress days because of issues with students not following the dress code. I know free dress days are exciting for the students and I want them to continue at Immacolata.

As a school this year, and throughout the Archdiocese over the next 2 years, we are continuing to move away from the ITBS as an assessment tool. As an entire school we will administer the NWEA test three times a year, fall, winter and spring. The high schools will also begin using the NWEA test for admittance into high school beginning this year. Test results will be shared with families at least twice a year. Testing will be for students in grades 1-8.

#### Pick-Up

Due to safety concerns, all students will need to be picked up through the regular carpool dismissal procedures in the parking lot on the west side of the school. There will be no pick up from the doors by the office. If you have a special circumstance, please contact the office so we can best determine how to meet your needs. Special circumstances should not happen on a consistent basis to get to after school practices.

Please call and leave a message at 314-991-5700 (ext. 302) if you have any questions. This program is operated under the administration of Mrs. Gaskell. Aftercare hours are from 3:00pm to 5:30pm.
